Notes to financial statements for the year ended 30 September 2010

1 Accounting policies

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Statement of Recommended Practice, Accounting and Reporting by Charities (SORP 2005) issued in March 2005, applicable United Kingdom accounting standards and the Companies Act 2006. The principal accounting policies adopted in the preparation of the financial statements are as follows:

a) Fund accounting

General funds are unrestricted funds which are available for use at the discretion of the trustees in furtherance of the general objectives of the charity and which have not been designated for other purposes.

b) Charitable trading activities

Income from membership subscriptions is included in incoming resources in the period in which it is receivable.

c) Grants, donations and gifts in kind

Income from grants and donations is included in incoming resources where these are receivable unless donors impose specific conditions.

d) Resources expended

All expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all costs related to the category.

Charitable activities include expenditure associated with operating the society and includes both direct costs and support costs relating to these activities. The Charity is not registered for VAT and accordingly expenditure is shown gross of irrecoverable VAT.

Governance costs include those incurred in the governance of the charity and its assets and are primarily associated with constitutional and statutory requirements.

2 Legal status of the charity

The charity is a company limited by guarantee and has no share capital. The liability of each member in the event of winding-up is limited to £10.
