February Yellow Brick Road (Old Stockport Canal) Clean-up - due to a diary clash with a Canal Society event, there were just 3 of us but lack of numbers did not mean lack of effort and we did a job clearing the section from the Ashton Old Rd bridge to the concrete 'tank traps' further up the path. In all, we filled 12 bags and finished just before the rain started (see picture)!
